EU directive on Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE)

WEEE stands for the EU directive on Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment. This directive was approved by 'The European Union' in January 2007, stating that organisations are no longer allowed to simply dispose of their equipment in skips or landfills.

"The Directive aims to reduce the waste arising from electrical and electronic equipment; it sets out to improve the environmental process of all of those involved in the life cycle of electrical and electronic equipment."

E-waste pallet (with the option of Asset Management*)

Toner Cartridge Recycling

The WEEE directive requires the removal of: "toner cartridges, liquid and paste, as well as colour toner". Toner cartridges are commonly found in printers, fax machines and photocopiers. Under the WEEE guidelines toner cartridges should be removed whole and intact so as to prevent the dispersal of toner in the material or waste streams. Toner powder, and consumables containing toner powder, is classed as hazardous waste therefore must be recycled in the proper manner.
